

**Tentative Agreement 2021-2022

Agreement to let the ISTA UniServ Director to make any change to make the contract compliant with IEERB.

Teachers with experience with Cannelton City School Corporation will receive a raise with a range of \$4,800 to \$1,100.

Permanent teachers with zero years of experience will receive a raise of \$2,400.

The salary range will be \$35,800 to \$60,400.

Every certificated employee will receive one-half percent of their salary deposited into a 401(a).

Employees will be offered an opportunity to deposit money into a 403(b). Security Benefits will be the 401 (a) and 403 (b) provider.

Remove Elementary Academic Coach

Change Academic Support Coordinator from \$526 to \$1,000

Change High School National Honor Society to \$500

Add Middle School National Honor Society at \$300
